# God's Presence among His People

- Exodus 33:2-3 "I will send an **angel** before you, and I will drive out the Canaanites, the Amorites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites. Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; but **I will not go up** among you, lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiffnecked people..."
- Exodous 33: 13 15 "Now therefore, if I have found favor in your sight, please show me now your ways, **that I may know you** in order to find favor in your sight. Consider too that this nation is **your people**." 14 And he said, "**My presence will go with you,** and I will give you rest." 15 And he said to him, "If your presence will not go with me, do not bring us up from here."




### **Judges**

Husband to His Bride (Ezekiel and Hosea)





# The Feast of Ingathering - Pentecost

• Eph. 1:18-23 "having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his **right hand** in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. 22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, 23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all."

  - 2 Cor. 6:16 "For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people."

  - "And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her <u>husband</u>. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and <u>God himself will be with them as their God</u>." (Rev. 21:2 3)

# Are you in Christ?

- "For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit. (1 Cor 12: 12 13)
- "for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise." (Gal. 3:26 29)
